ORDINANCE NO. 553

AN ORDINANCE relating to land use; and amending Section 4.18.52 of The Bellevue Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4.18.52 of Ordinance No. 68, passed on the 28th day of September, 1954, as amended by Ordinance No. 326, passed on the 13th day of October, 1959, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.18.52 Illuminated advertising signs on the property or on buildings within this district shall be so oriented that they face away from any adjoining residential district. All signs shall be an integral part of the architectural design, located on the buildings or on structures related to the buildings. Signs of billboard character or with flashing or blinking lights are prohibited. Attention-attracting devices such as streamers, flashers, twirlers, flashing lights, strings of banners or festooned lights are prohibited. Site illumination and necessary safety lighting and directional signs for traffic are permitted. In yard display areas only name and price tags on nursery stock and equipment, or age, name and price cards on the inside of cars or boats is permitted.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


