ORDINANCE NO. 554

AN ORDINANCE determining the public advantage in vacating 101st Ave. N.E., between N.E. 8th Street and N.E. 10th Street.

WHEREAS a resolution was adopted by the City Council on September 11, 1962, calling for a hearing to be held on October 16, 1962, to consider the advisability of vacating the property originally intended for the right of way for 101st Avenue N.E. from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street; and

WHEREAS the City Council gave notice thereof by posting and mailing in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS investigation was made as to the use of said street and the public interest to be served or damaged by a change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS a hearing was held upon said resolution on October 16, 1962, at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notices, and as a result thereof the City Council having found that the vacation of said street to the extent herein described would serve the public good; and no objections thereto being made by owners of private abutting property; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following street in the City of Bellevue, to-wit:

The following described property originally intended for the right of way for 101st Avenue N.E., from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street, and legally described as:
The West 50 feet of the East 340.70 feet of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington

is vacated.

Section 2. The Administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Auditor, and to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Assessor.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
