## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5673

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$200,000 in Federal Surface Transportation (STP) funding; authorizing execution of a contract with the Public Works Board for the acceptance of a \$750,000 Public Works Trust Fund (PWTF) Construction Program loan; and amending the 2005-2011General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the project budget for NE 24<sup>th</sup> Street - Northup Way to 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE (CIP Plan No. PW-WB-69) by \$2,034,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$200,000 in Federal Surface Transportation (STP) funding, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 39788.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a contract with the Public Works Board for the acceptance of a \$750,000 Public Works Trust Fund (PWTF) Construction Program loan, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 39846.

Section 3. The City's 2005-2011 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for NE 24<sup>th</sup> Street – Northup Way to 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-69) by \$2,034,000 to reflect the STP Grant, PWTF Loan, and the transfer of General CIP revenue totaling \$1,084,000 from the following projects:

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority

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necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreements.

Section 6. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

WSDOT

\$ 200,000

Provided, however if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
