

ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 17, re-establishing the hours for the transaction of business in the city offices and fixing hours of employment.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 17, passed on the 26th day of May, 1952, is repealed.

Section 2. All offices and departments of the City of Bellevue shall be kept open for the transaction of business with the public from the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., five days per week, Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays.

Section 3. All of such offices and departments shall be open and the employees thereof shall work from the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with one-half hour for lunch, five days per week, Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication.
