ORDINANCE NO. 572

AN ORDINANCE relating to real estate owned by the City of Bellevue for utility purposes; authorizing the issuance of license thereupon to Medicenter Partnership; and amending Ordinance No. 557.

WHEREAS the City owns a 16.5 foot strip of land, located between Overlake Memorial Hospital and property owned by Medicenter Partnership, which the City acquired at nominal cost for utility purposes; and

WHEREAS in order to facilitate the development of the Overlake Memorial Hospital and the medical center being developed by Medicenter Partnership, it is felt desirable to issue a license to Medicenter Partnership and upon said strip of land for vehicular traffic and parking purposes and for the installation of sanitary sewer lines; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 557, passed December 4, 1962, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The administration is hereby authorized to execute that certain License, copy of which has been received under Clerk's Receiving Number 641.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
