

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 586

AN ORDINANCE relating to vehicles; providing for the regulation thereof and of persons in relation thereto; amending Ordinance Nos. 27 and 527 and Chapters 11.52 and 11.82 of Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 527 and Chapter 11.82 of Bellevue City Code are each hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11.82.037 which shall read as follows:

11.82.037 Miscellaneous statutes adopted by reference designated. The following statutes are hereby adopted by this reference:

- (1) Chapter 13, Laws of 1961; R.C.W. 47.52.120
- (2) Chapter 122, Laws of 1961; R.C.W. 47.52.200

Section 2. Ordinance No. 27 and Chapter 11.52 of Bellevue City Code are each hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11.52.040 which shall read as follows:

11.52.040 Entering or leaving vehicle. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter, leave, or open a door on the roadway side of any vehicle whenever such action interferes with other traffic or constitutes a safety hazard; provided, however, that such provision shall not apply to a vehicle angle parked, nor to authorized emergency vehicles.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
