

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5893

AN ORDINANCE providing for the use of alternative contracting procedure methods in the contracting of public works projects; creating new Section 4.28.142 in the Bellevue City Code; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, alternative public works contracting procedures are authorized under state law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that use of job order contracts for certain public works will benefit the public by providing an effective means of reducing the total lead-time and cost for the construction of public works projects for repair and renovation required at public facilities through the use of unit price books and work orders by eliminating time-consuming, costly aspects of the traditional public works process, which require separate contracting actions for each small project; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section 4.28.142 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code as follows:

4.28.142 Alternative Public Works Contracting – Job Order Contracting

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter 4.28, when a determination is made by the applicable department director in conjunction with the purchasing manager that use of a job order contract will benefit the public, public works projects may be done pursuant to job order contracting procedures, as authorized by RCW 39.10.420 and in accordance with the job order contracting provisions and limitations of RCW chapter 39.10, as adopted herein.

A. Adoption by Reference. The city adopts by reference, as though fully set forth in this chapter, the following sections and subsections of RCW chapter 39.10, now or as hereafter amended:

RCW 39.10.430
RCW 39.10.440
RCW 39.10.450
RCW 39.10.460

B. Definitions. The city adopts by reference, as though fully set forth in this chapter, the definitions relating to job order contracting found in RCW 39.10.210, now or as hereafter amended.

C. Duties of purchasing manager. The purchasing manager shall be authorized to proscribe administrative procedures to carry out the obligations of the provisions adopted in section A above, including but not limited to procedures: establishing a committee to evaluate proposals under RCW 39.10.430; establishing a protest period and process consistent with RCW 39.10.430; ensuring compliance with the limitations on use of job order contracts and work orders.

Section 2. The alternative public works contracting procedure authorized under Section 1 above shall be terminated June 30, 2013.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days following its passage and legal publication.


