## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. <u>5938</u>

AN ORDINANCE related to residential permit parking amending Ordinance 5811 by extending the boundaries of Residential Permit Parking Zone 3, to include the west side of 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE from SE Wolverine Way to SE Cliff Place, restricting parking on the street to "No Parking 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, Except by Zone 3 Permit".

WHEREAS, Policy TR -119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones; and

WHEREAS, for decades the City has been working with residents living near Bellevue High School to address student spillover parking through implementation of a Residential Permit Parking Zone; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinance 5811 to address the residential parking issue; and

WHEREAS, these restrictions have been successful in addressing parking issues around Bellevue High School; and

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from residents living on the west side of 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE from SE Wolverine Way to SE Cliff Place, asking to be included in the RPZ created by Ordinance 5811; and

WHEREAS, there is a desire to ensure uniform enforcement of the zone restrictions around Bellevue High School; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 5811 is hereby amended to extend the boundaries of Residential Parking Zone 3 to include the west side of 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE from SE Wolverine Way to SE Cliff Place restricting parking of vehicles on the street to "No Parking 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, Except by Zone 3 Permit".

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.223.010 of the Bellevue City Code.
