ORDINANCE NO. 6210

AN ORDINANCE by amending Bellevue City Code Chapter 4.36.30- Damage Claims Against the City, to increase the settlement authority of the City Manager from \$20,000 to \$75,000.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4342 adopted in 1992, codified as Bellevue City Code 4.36.30B, set the threshold for the City's Manager's settlement authority at \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's settlement authority has remained at the \$20,000 level and has not been updated; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Code change increases the City Manager's settlement authority from \$20,000 to \$75,000 and is intended to streamline the settlement process; and.

WHEREAS, this amendment will enable the City to settle claims faster and more efficiently; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. BCC 4.36.030 B is hereby amended as follows:

BCC 4.36.030 B. City procedure: Settlements exceeding \$75,000 may be paid upon authorization of the City Council after receiving a report from the City Manager.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after passage by the City Council.


