ORDINANCE NO. 6256

AN ORDINANCE authorizing 1) an update and time extension of the Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Plan for 2015 through 2019; 2) Execution of an agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for receipt of 2015-2017 state funds, in the amount of \$204,946, to support the City's CTR program; 3) Amendment of the 2015-2016 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund appropriation in the amount of \$204,946; and, 4) Execution of an agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with King County Metro, in an amount up to \$237,597, for Commute Trip Reduction services at CTR-affected employer worksites and for services at Transportation Management Program (TMP)-affected building sites.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute 1) an update and time extension of the CTR Plan for 2015 through 2019; 2) an agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with the WSDOT for receipt of 2015-2017 state funds, in the amount of \$204,946, to support the City's CTR program; 3) an agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with King County Metro, in an amount up to \$237,597, for CTR services at CTR-affected employer worksites and for services at TMP-affected building sites, a copy of which extension and agreements shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No's. 56004, 56036, 56097.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreements.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to execute all documents (including supplemental documents) necessary or appropriate to fulfill the terms of the agreements authorized in Section 1.

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Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Washington State Department of Transportation \$204,946


Section 6. Upon execution of said grant agreement, the budget for 2015-2016 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$204,946 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant award should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation for the 2015-2016 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
