ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 49 and re-establishing the time and place of regular meetings of the Bellevue City Council.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Ordinance No. 49, heretofore passed by the City Council on the 12th day of January, 1954, is hereby repealed.

Section 2 - Regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Bellevue will be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month, commencing at the hour of 7:30 p.m..

Section 3 - The regular meeting place of the City Council of the City of Bellevue will be at the V.F.W. Hall, located on Main Street at 100th N.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 4 - This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five days after its passage, approval and publication.
