

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6403

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of Amendment No. 1 to the Service Agreement with the King County Flood Control District to accept additional reimbursement grant funds for the Lower Coal Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project ("Project"), CIP Plan No. D-106; and amending the 2017-2023 Utility Capital Investment Program (CIP) and the 2018 adopted Project budget to recognize \$6,025,000 of additional grant funds for the Project, and authorizing the expenditure of such funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Service Agreement with the King County Flood Control District and the City of Bellevue for the Lower Coal Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project, CIP Plan No. D-106; through its service provider, the King County Water and Land Resources Division, a copy of which amendment shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 73672.

Section 2. The City's 2017-2023 Utility Capital Investment Program (CIP) appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the total project budget of CIP Plan No. D-106 from \$8,687,889 to 14,712,889, and the 2018 adopted budget for CIP Plan No. D-106 is amended from \$2,475,000 to \$4,703,000 to recognize the award of \$6,025,000 in grants from the King County Flood Control District for the Lower Coal Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Amendment No. 1.

Section 4. If the actual revenue received shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund, Plan, and Project Budget Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
