ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 64 and reestablishing the time and place of regular meetings of the Bellevue City Council.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Ordinance No. 64 heretofore passed by the City Council on the 13th day of July, 1954, is hereby repealed.

Section 2 - Regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Bellevue will be held on Tuesday of each week at the hour of 7:30 p.m., commencing with the 7th day of September, 1954.

Section 3 - The regular meeting place of the City Council of the City of Bellevue will be at the V. F. W. Hall located on Main Street and 100th S. E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 4 - This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication.
