

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6666

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a Spill Prevention, Preparedness, and Response Equipment Grant Agreement with the State of Washington Department of Ecology to accept grant funds in the amount of \$166,900 for the purchase of hazardous materials air monitoring equipment; 2) amending the 2021-2022 budget, to authorize the acceptance and deposit of said funds into the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$166,900; 3) appropriating the unanticipated grant revenues to that fund; and 4) authorizing expenditures of said grant funds for the purchase of hazardous materials air monitoring equipment.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with State of Washington Department of Ecology to accept \$166,900 in grant funds, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The 2021 - 2022 budget as previously amended is hereby further amended to accept said grant funds to be deposited in the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund which is hereby amended to increase the appropriation by \$166,900.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received shall be more or less than the anticipated amount, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.


Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive said funds, to expend the same as provided for in said grant agreement, and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
