ORDINANCE NO. 6680

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2021-2027 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget for the Public-Private Partnerships – BelRed Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Project (CIP Plan No. CD-48) by \$2,000,000 and decrease the budget for the Station Area Planning Implementation – East Main/South Bellevue Project (CIP Plan No. CD-30) by \$2,000,000; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2021-2027 General CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Public-Private Partnerships – BelRed TOD Project (CIP Plan No. CD-48) by \$2,000,000 and decrease the budget for the Station Area Planning Implementation – East Main/South Bellevue Project (CIP Plan No. CD-30) by \$2,000,000.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
