

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6683

AN ORDINANCE (1) authorizing an amendment to a sub-contract with the Dispute Resolution Center of Kitsap County, as lead fiscal agent for Resolution Washington, to accept an additional \$165,832 in grant funding from the Administrative Office of the Courts (under personal services agreement PSC22019), to support Eviction Resolution Services offered through the Bellevue Conflict Resolution Center's Eviction Resolution Pilot Program during state fiscal year 2022 to 2023; and (2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$137,446.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to a sub-contract, previously executed (pursuant to Ordinance 6601), with the Dispute Resolution Center of Kitsap County, as lead fiscal agent for Resolution Washington, to accept an additional \$165,832 in grant funding from the Administrative Office of the Courts (under personal services agreement PSC22019), to support Eviction Resolution Services offered through the Bellevue Conflict Resolution Center's Eviction Resolution Pilot Program during state fiscal year 2022 to 2023, a copy of which sub-contract has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The City's 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said fund in the amount of \$137,446.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
