CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6686

AN ORDINANCE related to parking in residential permit parking zones; amending Section 11.23.020 of the Bellevue City Code to remove the exemption that allows people to park or re-park in residential permit parking zones on either side of a public street within the same block for a period exceeding 24 consecutive hours; and establishing an effective date.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.23.020 of the Bellevue City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Except for authorized time limit zones (BCC 11.23.022), no person may park or repark a vehicle on either side of a public street within the same block for a period exceeding 24 consecutive hours. A vehicle shall be deemed to be parked in violation of this section unless the vehicle is moved to a different block every 24 hours. For purposes of this section, a block is defined as the stretch of roadway between the two closest public street intersections on either end of the stretch. For cases where a roadway ends, a block is defined as the stretch of roadway between the end of the roadway and the closest public street intersection.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after adoption and legal publication.
