ORDINANCE NO. 6691

AN ORDINANCE 1) adopting the Human Services Commission's 2023-2024 Behavioral Health and Housing-Related Services Housing Stability Program funding recommendations and 2) authorizing the City Manager or his designee to enter into contracts with local human services agencies in accordance with the recommendations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council adopts the Behavioral Health and Housing-Related Housing Stability Program 2023-2024 funding recommendations as developed by the City of Bellevue Human Services Commission, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_, to act as guidelines for the allocation of 2023 and 2024 revenues derived from sales and use taxes for services authorized under RCW 82.14.530(2)(c), as such funding becomes available.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with local human services agencies to carry out the services described in the recommendations in the amount of funding specified for each agency.

Section 3. The terms and conditions of any such contracts shall ensure the City's funds are used for their intended purpose and consistent with the requirements of RCW 82.14.530.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
