

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6718

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$1,450,000 in federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding to support the construction of the South Downtown Bellevue Arterial Overlay Project (SDBA Overlay) as part of the Bridge and Pavement Preservation (Overlay) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1); and, 2) amending the 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget for the Bridge and Pavement Preservation (Overlay) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1) by \$1,450,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$1,450,000 in federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding to support the construction of the South Downtown Bellevue Arterial Overlay Project (SDBA Overlay) as part of the Bridge and Pavement Preservation (Overlay) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1), a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Bridge and Pavement Preservation (Overlay) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1) by \$1,450,000.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from Washington State Department of Transportation shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation to the CIP Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
