

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6729

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2023-2024 budget to increase the appropriation to the Housing Fund by \$571,639; providing for severability; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 6698, adopted November 21, 2022, and previously amended, the City Council set the City of Bellevue's 2023-2024 Budget, set forth the estimated revenues and appropriations, and established job classifications and pay ranges; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 10192, adopted December 8, 2022, the City Council approved the ARCH 2023 Administrative Budget and Work Program, as recommended by the ARCH Executive Board, and recognized the need for two (2) full-time equivalent positions to provide additional capacity and support for local housing programs, including the ARCH Homeownership Program, ARCH Rental Program, and Incentive Programs.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 6698, adopted November 21, 2022, and previously amended, is hereby further amended to amend the 2023-2024 budget to increase the Housing Fund appropriation by \$571,639 to support the previously approved ARCH 2023 Administrative Budget and Work Program;

Section 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
