ORDINANCE NO. 6733

AN ORDINANCE 1) amending the 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget for the I-405 Non-Motorized Crossing project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-216) by \$2,500,000; and 2) amending the 2023-2024 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$2,500,000 to reflect the donation agreement executed with Amazon on November 7, 2022.

WHEREAS on November 7, 2022 the City Manager's Office received and executed a donation agreement with Amazon for \$2,500,000 to advance early design work to improve pedestrian and bicycle connections across I-405 as part of the Grand Connection Vision; and

WHEREAS Amazon's donation is contingent upon a City match of \$2,500,000 which was allocated in the adopted 2023-2029 CIP I-405 Non-Motorized Crossing project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-216) for the preliminary design of the initial I-405 Non-Motorized Crossing; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The 2023-2024 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase appropriation to said CIP Fund \$2,500,000 with funds donated by Amazon.

Section 2. The City's 2023-2029 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the I-405 Non-Motorized Crossing project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-216) by \$2,500,000.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


