## ORDINANCE NO. 6735

AN ORDINANCE (1) amending the 2023-2029 CIP Plan to increase the budget for 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE Stage 4, NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street to Northup Way (CIP Plan No. PW-R-186) by \$3,820,000 to reflect federal Surface Transportation Program funding awarded by the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) to support the right of way (ROW) phase of the project; providing for severability; (2) amending the 2023-2024 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$3,820,000; and, establishing an effective date.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6698 on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE (Stage 4) – NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street to Northup Way (CIP Plan No. PW-R-186) by \$3,820,000 to reflect federal Surface Transportation Program funding awarded by the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) to support the right of way (ROW) phase of the project.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 6698, adopted on November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the 2023-2024 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$ 3,820,000.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
