ORDINANCE NO. 676

AN ORDINANCE annexing contiguous unincorporated territory, including Woodridge and Norwood Village, based upon the results of an annexation election.

WHEREAS the registered voters within the territory described below did vote on July 21, 1964 upon the proposition of whether or not to annex to the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS over a majority of the votes cast were in favor of annexation; and

WHEREAS there has been filed with the City (1) a certified copy of the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners, King County, Washington, finding that the voters of said area approved the annexation, and (2) a certified abstract of the vote showing the whole number who voted at the election, the number of votes cast for annexation and the number cast against annexation; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are described as follows:

All of Section 4 and East half of Section 5, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M. EXCEPT that portion within the existing city limits of Bellevue as established in Res. No. 13925 of 3/31/53 and Ord. No. 207 of 7/9/57, Ord. No. 331 of 12/8/59, Ord. No. 333 of 11/3/59 and Ord. No. 368 of 4/5/60.

Together with the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M. EXCEPT that portion within the existing city limits of Bellevue as established in Res. No. 13925 of 3/31/53 and Ord. No. 205 of 7/4/57.

Together with a portion of Section 9, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M. described as follows: Beginning at the NE corner of said Section, thence southerly along the east line of said Section to a point 30 feet south of the centerline of Primary State Highway No. 2 as now existing, thence westerly along a line parallel to and 30 feet southerly of said centerline of Primary State Highway No. 2 as now existing to the intersection with the easterly right-of-way margin of the Northern Pacific Railroad and the existing Bellevue City limits as established in Ord. No. 213 of 10/15/57, thence generally northerly, westerly, northerly and westerly along said city limits to an intersection with the city limits of Bellevue as established in Ord. No. 205 of 7/4/57, thence northerly and westerly along said city limits to an intersection with the west line of Section 9, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M., thence north along said west line of Section 9, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M., to the NW corner of said Section, thence easterly along the north line of said Section 9 to the NE corner thereof, and the point of beginning.

Together with a portion of Section 10, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M., described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the E-W centerline of said Section with the west line of said Section; thence southerly along said west line to a point 30 feet south of the centerline of Primary State Highway No. 2 as now existing, thence easterly along a line parallel to and 30 feet southerly of said centerline of Primary State Highway No. 2 as now existing to a point 560' (Five Hundred Sixty Feet) west of the west line of the E ½ of the E ½ of Section 10 thence northerly parallel to said west line to an intersection with the E-W centerline of said Section; thence westerly along said E-W centerline to the intersection with the east line of the W ½ of the W ½ of the E ½ of said Section; thence northerly along said east line to the north line of said Section; thence westerly along said north line to the NW corner of said Section; thence southerly along the west line of said Section to the point of beginning.

Together with the west half of the west half of Section 3, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M.

Situate in King County, Washington.

Section 2. The above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 11 day of August, 1964, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.


Section 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.




