ORDINANCE NO. 677

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE determining the public advantage in vacating the plat of Cedar Glen, King County, Washington, upon the application of Day.

WHEREAS a petition was filed with the City Council to vacate the plat of Cedar Glen by the owner of all of the property included therein; and

WHEREAS the City Council by resolution fixed the time for hearing said petition and gave notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS investigation was made as to said plat and the use of the streets contained therein, and the public interest to be served or damaged by the vacation of the plat and by the vacation of the streets therein; and

WHEREAS a hearing was held upon said petition on August 18, 1964, at the time and place fixed in said resolution, and as a result thereof the City Council having found that the vacation of said plat would serve the public good; and no objections thereto being made by owners of any property contained within said plat; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The plat of Cedar Glen, recorded in Volume 63 of Plats, page 59, records of King County, Washington, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. The Administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Auditor, and to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the King County Assessor.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
