

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE establishing a department of streets and public works, defining its functions, and providing for its personnel.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is established a department of streets and public works whose function it shall be to design and supervise the construction, maintenance and repair of streets, alleys and other public ways within the City of Bellevue; to examine and pass upon plans for public works; to supervise the construction of the same, and to advise and make recommendations concerning the granting of franchises to use the public streets and other public property.

Section 2. The functions of such department shall be executed under the supervision and control of a Superintendent of Streets and Public Works. Such Superintendent shall be appointed for an indefinite term by the City Manager for his executive and administrative ability and training and experience in such work. The City Manager shall designate, upon recommendation of the Superintendent, the number of assistants to such Superintendent or other employees of such department, and subject to the limitations prescribed by any civil service regulations then adopted by the City Council and in force, the City Manager shall have the power of removal of such Superintendent or his subordinates.

Section 3. The City Council may adopt regulations from time to time determining the qualifications for the office, prescribing compensation to be paid, and defining additional powers and duties to be exercised and performed by the Superintendent of Streets and Public Works and his subordinates, in addition to the duties prescribed in Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication, or posting, in the manner provided by law.
