

**CITY OF BELLEVUE  
ORDINANCE NO. 74.**

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 11 and fixing salaries for certain City employees. THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO HEREBY ADOPT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Section 3 of Ordinance No. 11 adopted on the 5th day of May, 1953 is amended to provide as follows:

"**Section 3.** Such City Manager shall be compensated for his services to the City of Bellevue on the basis of a monthly salary of \$550.00. Such salary shall be payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council."

**Section 2.** There is created a classification of employees to perform clerical-typist services in such department or departments as the City Manager shall recommend. Such clerk-typists shall serve at the pleasure of the City Manager and shall be compensated for services on the basis of \$215.00 month payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 3.** There is created a classification of city employee to be known as Street Foreman whose duties shall be set by the City Manager and who shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of \$400.00 per month payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 4.** The hourly wage for laborers who shall perform services on behalf of the City in any department to be designated by the City Manager in connection with employment for which no other work classification or salary has been established shall be from \$1.85 to \$2.20 per hour as authorized by the City Manager, depending upon the skill, experience or other ability of the several members of such class of employees.

**Section 5.** There is created a classification of city employee to be known as City Inspector whose duties shall be set by the City Manager and who shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of \$375.00 per month payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.

**Section 3.** There is created a classification of city employee to be known as Street Foreman whose duties shall be set by the City Manager and who shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of \$400.00 per month payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 4.** The hourly wage for laborers who shall perform services on behalf of the City in any department to be designated by the City Manager in connection with employment for which no other work classification or salary has been established shall be from \$1.85 to \$2.20 per hour as authorized by the City Manager, depending upon the skill, experience or other ability of the several members of such class of employees.

**Section 5.** There is created a classification of city employee to be known as City Inspector whose duties shall be set by the City Manager and who shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of \$375.00 per month payable monthly or semi-monthly as shall be fixed by resolution of the City Council.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
