

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE annexing a portion of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W. M. to the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, a written petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Bellevue for the annexation of the territory herein described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has examined the petition and has found, upon satisfactory proof, that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than 75% in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property therein described, and in all respects has met the requirements of Chapter 128, Laws of 1945 of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council fixed the 23rd day of November, 1954 as the date for public hearing thereon and caused notice of such hearing to be published in accordance with the law, and the hearing having been held on said date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Bellevue will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of the City of Bellevue and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.


Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory to be annexed to the City of Bellevue are hereby described as follows:

The East half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W. M. less a parcel beginning 660 feet west of the Southeast corner of said Northwest quarter, thence east 177.5 feet, thence North 955 feet, thence West 45.5 feet, thence North 365 feet, thence West 132 feet, thence South 1320 feet to the point of beginning in King County, Washington.

Section 3. That the above described territory shall become a part of the City of Bellevue on the 7th day of December, 1954, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances then and thereafter in force.

Section 4. That copies of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
