## ordinance no. \_ 80

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 25 and reestablishing fire zones within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 25 passed the 24th day of June, 1954 is repealed.

Section 2. Fire Zones Established. Whenever reference is made in this ordinance to a fire zone, it shall refer to the area described herein or established by reference to boundary descriptions contained in Ordinance No. 68, passed the 7th day of October, 1954. When such areas or districts are altered hereafter by amendatory ordinances, the fire zones herein established by reference to such essential use districts shall be deemed to be amended to include the essential use district as altered by such amendatory ordinance.

Section 3. Fire Zone I shall include all territory within the retail business districts in the City of Bellevue which is described in Section 2.10 of Ordinance No. 68 (or as hereafter amended) as constituting B-1 essential use district.

Section 4. Fire Zone 2 shall include all territory within retail business, commercial and manufacturing districts in the City of Bellevue which are described in Section 2.10 of Ordinance No. 68 (or as hereafter amended) as constituting BN, C-1 and CM essential use districts.

Section 4. Fire Zone 3 shall include all areas within the City of Bellevue exclusive of the areas lying within the retail business, commercial or manufacturing use districts.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting.
