

ORDINANCE NO. 92

AN ORDINANCE vacating an alley and reserving an easement for public utilities in Block 2 of Strong's Highland Drive Addition.

WHEREAS, petition was filed with the City Council to vacate an alley, below described, by the owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by resolution fixed the time for hearing said petition and gave notice thereof by posting in the manner required by law and on the 27th day of July, 1954, the date fixed in said resolution and notice, said petition was duly heard and favorably considered by the City Council; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That alley 12 feet in width lying between the westerly boundaries of Lots 2 and 3 and the easterly boundaries of Lots 4 through 9, inclusive, all of Block 2 Strong's Highland Drive Addition and connecting N. E. 5th Street and 98th Place N. E. is vacated; provided, however, that an easement is reserved for the location, installation, use, repair and maintenance of pipes, poles, cables or lines or other fixtures or appurtenances of public utilities within or above such vacated alley.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from and after its passage and publication.
