

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE determining the public advantage in vacating portions of 109th Place N. E., N. E. 10th Street and N. E. 11th Street within the plat of Ranch Homes Addition.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Council to vacate portions of 109th Place N. E., N. E. 10th Street and N. E. 11th Street, below described, by owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by resolution fixed the time for hearing said petition and gave notice thereof by posting in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, investigation was made as to the use of said street and the public interest to be served or damaged in a change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was had upon the petition on the First day of June, 1954 at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notice, and there being no objection from the abutting owners and the City Council having found that the area will be within school grounds and that the vacation of the street through said grounds will better serve the public good and that the abutting property will be adequately served from remaining existing streets and that vacation of said portions of streets would be to the public interest; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of 109th Place N. E. and that portion of N. E. 10th Street lying within the plat of Ranch Homes Addition together with that portion of N. E. 11th Street lying between the westerly line of Lot 1, Block 3 extended across said street and the easterly margin of 110th Avenue N. E. according to the plat thereof recorded in volume 50 of Plats, page 3, records of King County is vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
