RESOLUTION NO. 1003

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 62-S-28 for the improvement of portions of N.E. 6th Street and 110th Avenue N.E.; and authorizing issuance of warrants to cover accrued interest, and payment to bond counsel and others.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:
