RESOLUTION no. 1020

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of 110th Avenue N.E. and north of Main Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of 110th Avenue N.E. and north of Main Street, in the City of Bellevue lying east of a line which is parallel to and 30 feet east of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Main Street in said city, from which the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 32, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., bears S 88°03'32" E, 676.80 feet; thence N 00°12'49" E to the south boundary of Jensen's Addition to Bellevue as recorded in volume 49 of plats, page 70, records of King County, Washington.

EXCEPT that portion lying within N.E. 2nd Street.

on the 5th day of November, 1963, at the hour of 8:10 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, 835 - 106th Avenue N.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
