RESOLUTION NO. 10297

A RESOLUTION amending the Hearing Examiner Rules of Procedure and repealing Resolution No. 9474.

WHEREAS, under Bellevue City Code 3.68.250D the Hearing Examiner is authorized to prescribe rules and regulations concerning procedures for hearings and other proceedings subject to confirmation by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, such Rules of Procedure have been previously adopted by the Hearing Examiner and confirmed by the City Council by Resolution Nos. 3645, 5552, 6408 and 9474; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2022, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 6673, which amended Chapter 20.35 of the Land Use Code to eliminate quasi-judicial appeals to the City Council of Hearing Examiner decisions and recommendations in Process I and III land use matters; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2023, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 6731, which amended the Shoreline Master Program, Chapter 20.25E, and Chapter 20.35 of the Land Use Code, to eliminate quasi-judicial appeals to the City Council of Hearing Examiner decisions related to shoreline decisions; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Hearing Examiner has now prescribed amended Rules of Procedure to conform to the elimination of quasi-judicial appeals to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to confirm the amended Rules of Procedure, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby confirms the Rules of Procedure of the Office of the Hearing Examiner, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. 80638, which shall supersede the Rules of Procedure confirmed by Resolution No. 9474.
