RESOLUTION NO. 1030

A RESOLUTION regarding the annexation of contiguous unincorporated territory, including Sherwood Forest.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby determine that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Bellevue would be served by the annexation of the following-described unincorporated territory which is contiguous to the City of Bellevue:

Portions of Sections 23, 26 and 27, Twp. 25 N., R. 5E., W.M. described as follows:

Beg. at the intersection of a Line 42' South of the S. line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$, of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 27, said Twp. & Range, with the W. line of said Sec. 27; thence easterly along said line and parallel with the S. line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 27, to the centerline of 148th Ave. N.E.; thence southerly along said centerline to the South margin of County Road No. 966;

Thence northeasterly and easterly along said south margin to the east line of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 26, Twp. 25 N., R. 5 E., W.M.; thence northerly to the south line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 26;

Thence easterly along said line to the centerline of the Bellevue-Redmond Road; thence northeasterly along said centerline to the E-W Center line of Sec. 23, Twp. 25 N., R. 5 E., W.M.; thence easterly along said centerline to the east line of said Sec. 23; thence southerly along said line to the N.E. corner of Sec. 26 said Twp. and Range; thence continuing southerly along the east line of said Sec. to the East-West centerline thereof; thence westerly along said centerline to the east line of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec.;

Thence southerly along said line to the north line of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec.; thence westerly along said north line to the west line of Sec. 27, thence northerly to the point of beginning.

Situate in King County, Washington.

Section 2. That, as nearly as may be, the number of voters residing in the aforesaid territory is 487.

Section 3. The City Council does hereby pray that the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, call an election to be held among the qualified voters in the aforesaid territory upon the question of annexation.

Section 4. That the cost of said annexation election shall be paid by the City of Bellevue.


Section 5. That a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, in which county said territory is located.
