

RESOLUTION NO. 1032

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-20 for the improvement of N.E. 2nd Street, from 108th Avenue N.E. to 112th Avenue N.E., and authorizing payment of second draw to contractor, and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of December 13, 1963, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing Inc., the sum of \$19,248.57; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;
