RESOLUTION NO. 1034

A RESOLUTION relating to the 1963 Budget; and authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in 1963.

WHEREAS Section 4 of Chapter 166 of the Laws of 1961, as embodied in R.C.W. 35.33.120, permits the City Council to readjust the municipal budget by making expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues when authorized by resolution duly adopted by the majority vote of all members of the Council; and

WHEREAS the City received \$5,849.17 from the sale of materials and property for the improvement of streets, and \$1,209.00 for damages incurred by a Police Department motorcycle; and

WHEREAS the funds so received were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1963 Budget; and

WHEREAS it is to the best interests of the City that such excess revenues be appropriated as hereinafter recited; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1963 Budget Ordinance No. 550, approved by the City Council on the 2nd day of October, 1962, and all amendments thereto, is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited, and the same are hereby budgeted by increasing the following items:
