RESOLUTION NO. 1038

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of 108th Avenue N.E. within the City of Bellevue, upon the application of Nickols and others.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Norwood N. Nickols and others, interested property owners, for the vacation of a portion of 108th Avenue N.E. in the City of Bellevue described as follows:


The westerly 20 feet of the easterly 50 feet of the north half of Lot 3, Block 2, Cheriton Fruit Gardens, Plat No. 1, according to plat recorded in Volume 7 of Plats, page 47, in King County, Washington, EXCEPT the north 90 feet thereof,

Bellevue, King County, Washington, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 1964, at the hour of 2:15 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, 835 - 106th Avenue N.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.


Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
