RESOLUTION NO. 1040

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-20 for the improvement of N.E. 2nd Street, from 108th Avenue N.E. to 112th Avenue N.E., and authorizing payment of third draw to contractor.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 3, dated October 21, 1963	40,390.19
Warrants No. 4 through 11, dated December 18, 1963	19,564.60


WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of January 31, 1964, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing Inc., the sum of \$9,020.16;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue as follows:


