

## RESOLUTION NO. 1041

A RESOLUTION declaring the Council's intention regarding the use of the proceeds of the proposed \$1,500,000 Street Improvement Bonds, and specifically as to sidewalks for school children.

ORIGINAL

WHEREAS the Council did on January 21, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 632 declaring the need for the improvement of arterial and other streets within the City and the installation of traffic controls thereon, and did call for a special election to be held on March 10, 1964, and in conjunction with the City General Election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the question of whether the City should borrow the sum of \$1,500,000 and issue its negotiable general obligation bonds therefor; and

WHEREAS the Council did on February 4, 1964, pass Resolution No. 1039 declaring its intention as to the use of the proceeds of said bonds as to streets generally; and

WHEREAS it is thought desirable that the Council declare its intention regarding the use of the proceeds of said bonds for the construction of sidewalks to be primarily used by school children; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Council to improve a number of hard-surfaced sidewalks, including but not limited to sidewalks on the following named streets in the vicinity of local schools, which sidewalks include those proposed by the Bellevue School District staff, and which sidewalks, while enjoyed by all, will be of special benefit to children:


104th from S.E. 8th to the south City Limits  
108th from S.E. 34th to Main Street  
108th from N.E. 10th Street to N.E. 24th  
N.E. 24th from 108th to 98th Avenue N.E.  
100th from N.E. 10th to N.E. 24th  
N.E. 14th from 98th to 100th  
Kilmarnoch from 104th to the high school entrance  
S.E. 23rd from 104th to 108th  
N.E. 21st from 98th to 100th  
N.E. 12th from 108th to 112th  
N.E. 98th from 24th to 31st

Section 2. That the Council intends to pay for such sidewalks from the proceeds of the general obligation bonds.


Section 3. That the foregoing sidewalks shall be in addition to those which will be built in the business, commercial and residential areas as part of street improvement programs and paid for in whole or in part from the proceeds of the bonds.
