RESOLUTION NO. 1042

A RESOLUTION IN REGARD TO L.I.D. NO. 63-L-47 for the improvement of 106th Avenue, from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, and authorizing payments of first and second draws to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 15, 1963, pass Ordinance No. 619 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, and creating Local Improvement District No. 63-L-47 therefor; and

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of February 17, 1964 approved and recommended payment to Ott-Atwater Inc. the sum of \$3,142.90 and under date of February 26, 1964 approved and recommended payment to Ott-Atwater Inc. the sum of \$2,413.75; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of


