RESOLUTION NO. 1050

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 59-S-14 for the improvement of 112th Avenue S.E. from Main Street to S.E. 8th Street, and authorizing payment to contractor.

WHEREAS the City Council did on April 12, 1960, pass Ordinance No. 365 for the improvement of 112th Avenue S.E. from Main Street to S.E. 8th Street, and creating Local Improvement District No. 59-S-14 therefor, and did thereafter let a contract for said public works project; and

WHEREAS a contract was let on the 17 day of December, 1963, to Bellevue Bulldozing Inc. for certain modifications thereto; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:


Warrants No. 1 through 5, dated July 5, 1960	\$ 5,000.00
Warrants No. 6 through 9, dated August 8, 1960	3,424.62
Warrants No. 10 through 19, dated August 29, 1960	9,044.04
Warrants No. 20 through 31, dated October 3, 1960	11,633.15
Warrants No. 32 through 36, dated December 18, 1960	4,867.96

AND WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of April 16, 1964, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing Inc. the sum of \$15,251.26; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-one Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Hughbanks, Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
