RESOLUTION NO. 1060

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION relating to the Comprehensive Plan for the physical development of the City of Bellevue; regarding the amendment thereof, and amending Resolution No. 761.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section VI of Resolution No. 761, is hereby amended to read as follows:


VI. AMENDMENT The Planning Commission is charged with the responsibility of continuous observation of the development of the City in relation to the Plan. Where development or the absence of development indicates a condition, a problem, a new element, or expansion, unforeseen and not anticipated by the Plan the Commission shall study the subject, and shall hold a hearing thereon in the manner provided for reclassification of property, with posting and publication; provided however, that the newspaper publication may be informal and may refer to the common designation of the property, rather than the legal description. Following the hearing, the Commission may, at a regular meeting, recommend an amendment of the Plan to the Council. The Council shall hold a public hearing thereon, giving notice of the time and place by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City, and by posting at six places within the City. Following the hearing the Council may affirm, modify or disaffirm any recommendation of the Commission.
