RESOLUTION NO. 1070

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 63-L-47 for the improvement of 106th Avenue, from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, and authorizing payment of the final draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

ORIGINAL

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 15, 1963, pass Ordinance No. 619 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street by installing a street lighting system thereon, and did create Local Improvement District No. 63-L-47 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated March 10, 1964	\$5,685.89
Warrant No. 2, dated April 23, 1964	12,200.70
Warrant No. 3, dated May 13, 1964	22,217.51

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of June 16, 1964 approved and recommended the final payment to Ott-Atwater Inc. the sum of \$2,733.32; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-four and 47/100 Dollars (\$ 4,384.47) to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
