RESOLUTION NO. 1073

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 63-S-48 for the improvement of N.E. 4th Street from 100th Avenue N.E. to 104th Avenue N.E., and 102nd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 4th Street; authorizing payment of first draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on May 5, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 652 for the improvement of N.E. 4th Street from 100th Avenue N.E. to 104th Avenue N.E., and 102nd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 4th Street, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 63-S-48 therefor; and

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of June 30, 1964 approved and recommended payment to Bass Construction Company the sum of \$9,576.45; and

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of Nine Thousand ~~Six Hundred Forty-two~~ ^{and 45/100} Dollars (\$ ~~9,642.45~~ ^{9,576.45}) to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Hughbanks, Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
