RESOLUTION NO. 1077

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate an alley between 99th Avenue N.E. and 100th Avenue N.E. and north of N.E. 1st Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Bellevue Boys' Club and others for the vacation of an alley between 99th Avenue N.E. and 100th Avenue N.E. and north of N.E. 1st Street, in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

That portion of the alley abutting Lots 8, 9, 14, and the north 50 feet of Lot 13, Block 4, Plat of Lochleven, as recorded in Volume 16 of Plats, Page 46, records of King County,


on the 6th day of October, 1964, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
