RESOLUTION NO. 1078

A RESOLUTION fixing the time and place for a hearing on a petition to vacate the plat of Cedar Glen, King County, Washington.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of John W. Day for the vacation of the plat of Cedar Glen, Bellevue, King County, Washington, on the 18th day of August, 1964, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing shall be served, as in the manner provided for service of summons in civil actions, upon all of the owners of property not joining in said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
