RESOLUTION NO. 1081

A RESOLUTION establishing rules of procedure for the conduct of City Council meetings; and amending Resolution No. 866.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Resolution No. 866, passed by the City Council on the 11th day of July, 1961, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Order of Business. The order of business for each regular meeting shall be as follows:

- (a) Call to order.
- (b) Roll Call.
- (c) Approval of the minutes of the preceding meeting.
- (d) Consideration of bids, L.I.D., and related matters.
- (e) Hearing of petitions, applications, complaints, appeals, communications, etc.
- (f) Reports of committees.
- (g) Reports of officers.
- (h) Auditing of accounts.
- (i) Unfinished business.
- (j) New business.
- (k) Resolutions, ordinances, orders, rules and regulations.
- (l) Adjournment.
