RESOLUTION NO. 1084

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 63-L-47 for the improvement of 106th Avenue, from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, and authorizing payment of miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 15, 1963, pass Ordinance No. 619 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street by installing a street lighting system thereon, and did create Local Improvement District No. 63-L-47 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated March 10, 1964	\$5,685.89
Warrant No. 2, dated April 23, 1964	12,200.70
Warrant No. 3, dated May 13, 1964	22,217.51
Warrant No. 4, dated June 25, 1964	4,384.47

AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

Puget Sound Power and Light Co., remove light standards	53.47

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of one thousand three hundred sixty-five and 50/100 dollars (\$ 1,365.50) to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
