RESOLUTION NG. 1089

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention of the Council to participate in the construction, furnishing, establishment and maintenance of a regional library, and Soliciting the cooperation of neighboring cities and towns.

WHEREAS a large adequate library is screly needed on the East Side; and

WHEREAS patrons of such a library would reside both within the unincorporated area on the East Side, and also in the many municipalities, including Bellevue; and

WHEREAS it would be costly for one municipality to attempt to establish such a library, and it would be impracticable, in light of the large portion of patrons of such a library living outside the municipality in which the library were physically situated; and

WHEREAS R.C.W. 27.12.080 makes provision for regional libraries, whereby municipalities can cooperate in the catablishment and maintenance of such a facility; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue as follows:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby declare its intention to seek the construction, furnishing, establishment and maintenance of a regional library located on the East Side of Lake Washington.

Section 2. The Library Services and Construction Act, passed by Congress in 1964, provides federal funds to assist in the establishment of libraries.

Section 3. The City Council does hereby declare its intention to present to the electors of the City of Bellevue the proposition of the issuance of general obligation bonds with which to pay Bellevue's share of the cost of the construction, furnishing and establishment of such a regional library.

Section 4. The City Council does hereby solicit the cooperation of neighboring cities in the establishment, maintenance and sharing of the cost of such a facility.

Section 5. This resolution presupposes the receipt of a grant under the terms of the Library Services and Construction Act to assist in paying the cost of the establishment of such z iscility.
