RESOLUTION NO. 1120

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of S.E. 1st Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Aeolis Company and others for the vacation of a portion of S.E. 1st Street in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

That portion of S.E. 1st Street lying between the westerly margin of 105th Ave. S.E., and the westerly line and its projection to the north, of Tract 57, Maxwelton Braes Addition, said portion of street being approximately 40 feet by 134.38 feet in extent,

on the 5th day of January, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
